## Introducing a Tiered Membership Program for Sportsmen's Tennis and Enrichment Center

In September 2011, Sportsmen's Tennis Club will formally change its name to Sportsmen's Tennis and Enrichment Center, a name that we believe more accurately describes our core mission: ***To raise physically and academically healthy young adults, with a passion for learning and a commitment to excellence in all facets of life.*** In conjunction with this name change (about which you will hear more in the weeks ahead), Sportsmen's is introducing a tiered membership program that will more fully engage our adult players in supporting the Boston children, youth, and young adults whom we serve.

More than 3,000 Boston school-aged children and youth experienced tennis through Sportsmen's last year, both at the Dorchester campus and at local schools and community centers. Most of these youngsters come from the nearby neighborhoods of Dorchester, Roxbury, and Mattapan which, as compared to the rest of Boston, have higher minority representation per capita; residents with lower education levels; youth with lower MCAS scores and fewer options for healthy, affordable out-of-school time activities; and experience more significant violence. In a new strategic plan, Sportsmen's has reaffirmed its commitment to these neighborhoods and to the healthy development of their children, youth, and young adults. Through a wide range of tennis, academic enrichment, healthy lifestyles, and life skills programs, Sportsmen's seeks to improve the educational, physical, and cultural opportunities for all the boys and girls, young men and women who walk through its doors or participate in its Match Point tennis and health programs at their schools, health centers, or community centers.

The time-honored motto of Sportsmen's reminds us that *Adults pay so kids can play*. As Sportsmen's seeks to expand its reach into its neighboring communities and increase its impact on the lives of the youth whom it serves, we invite our adult players to help us advance these efforts with your philanthropic support through our new membership program.

## Impact

*Here are some examples of how your financial support can increase Sportsmen's impact on the overall health, well-being, and future opportunities of the children and youth we serve.*

**Platinum** – A Platinum membership underwrites the equivalent of 40 hours of instruction and coaching in any of the wide range of tennis programs for children and youth ages four to eighteen—or could allow 20 elementary-age children to attend the “Ready Position” academic enrichment after-school program at a reduced cost.

**Gold** – A Gold membership equates to scholarships for 12 neighborhood children to participate in Sportsmen's summer camp, or could help us expand our childhood obesity programs that use tennis to help children develop healthy lifestyles.

**Silver** – A Silver membership could help fund the gender-specific leadership development programs **HEY** (High Energy Young) **Sister** and **DEUCE** (Don't Ever Underestimate Consistent Effort) that engage youth in making healthy choices on and off the court—or help underwrite the cost of the developmental junior tennis program for a promising young player from the neighboring Franklin Hill or Franklin Field Apartments.

**Bronze** – We are grateful for the commitment of all our adult players in paying the membership and court fees that help us support our facility and programs with some of the lowest rates available in Greater Boston.
